## TERM ONE

At St Albans Meadows Primary School, students have the opportunity to learn the Italian language and study the Italian culture. Students from Foundation to Year Six study Italian for forty minutes per week.

Our focus is on communicating and understanding how a language works and gaining insights into the culture which gives the language its life and meaning. Students learn to communicate in Italian for many purposes and in many contexts.

This term, students in Foundation will be focusing on developing their listening and speaking skills.

We will be learning about where Italy is in the world and the Italian flag. We will look at the design of the Italian flag and will focus on learning colours in Italian. We will also be learning basic greetings, basic classroom instructions and begin to learn to count in Italian.

Students in years 1 to 6 will learn about Carnevale, the traditional festival celebrated in Italy.

Students will also be developing their language skills to greet others, to introduce themselves and answer questions about themselves in Italian.
