Curriculum

The children will continue tasks and assessments in English and Mathematics. They will be working on activities that are specifically tailored to their needs.

In Numeracy the students will continue working on Prime Mathematics. All of the Grade 6 students have enjoyed taking part in Prime Maths this year and have found it very engaging.

In Literacy, students will focus on writing memoirs about their time at SAMPS. They will be studying texts that relate to our Humanities topic 'Bizarre Bazaar.'

In Humanities this Term, students will gain an understanding of the design and production processes of creating a brand new product through the unit of 'Bizarre Bazaar'. They will take part in the 'Smoothie Bar' incursion.

The students will be looking at SMART spelling each week and will have spelling words that they must complete for homework.
