Curriculum

LITERACY

The children will continue tasks and assessments in English and Mathematics. They will be working on activities that are specifically tailored to their needs.

In Writing, students will focus on using persuasive language and techniques connecting to our social justice topic. They'll also write and perform a spoken word poem using poetic devices to enhance their ability to express themselves. Their exploration into writing will be supported by reading a variety of mentor texts that will focus on vocabulary, making connections and comprehension strategies. Additionally, students will continue their spelling program with weekly tests.

MATHEMATICS

We will continue our PRIME Mathematics learning, developing our understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages.

During the time of the Olympic games, we will be focusing on data and the different ways we can display those results. We also encourage students to regularly practise their times tables to improve their problem-solving skills.

INQUIRY

In Inquiry, students will explore social justice - investigate the rights of children and how aid agencies support essential needs across the world. They will learn about the challenges children face globally and how they can contribute to making a positive impact.
