Curriculum Overview

Inquiry:

Our topic is 'Our Sustainable World' where we will explore actions that we can take to help sustain the environment. We will look at when different fruits grow where they live and grow vegetables in our classrooms. We investigate the difference between good rubbish and bad rubbish and consider sustainable ways that we can stay warm in winter and stay cool in summer.

Mathematics:

We continue to explore Prime and grow our knowledge of number, shape and patterns this Term.

The following concepts will be taught:


- 2D Shapes
- Patterns
- Breaking Apart & Making Numbers 6 to 10
- Addition & Subtraction Within 10

Literacy:

Students will continue to participate in the Little Learners Love Literacy (LLLL) program.

Focus:

- Learn new letter-sound connections
 - Separate and blend sounds to read 3 letter words with known sounds
 - Spell 3 letter words with known sounds
 - Build comprehension after reading texts



Our 'Author Study' unit on Mem Fox will begin. We will use Mem Fox books to build our reading skills and read for enjoyment.

Focus:

- Learn about the role of an author and illustrator
- Make text-to-self connections
- Sequence events in the story
- Identify features of the story
- Infer how the character is feeling



Students will continue to build their fluency in writing simple sentences and apply skills learnt from the LLLL program to support them to begin expanding sentences.

Focus:

- Letter formation
- Capital letters at the beginning of sentences
- Full stops at the end of sentences
- Spaces between words
- Letter-sound connections
- Reading back their text
- The importance of word order
